A snowy February is now behind us. We didn't have any request to have "The Colours" present during any events in February.

We are planning on hosting a Vimy **Ridge and Tarnak Farm Memorial** in the Club and Unionville rooms, on Saturday April 11th 2020. For those not familiar with the Tarnak Farm Incident in Afghanistan, on the 17th April 2002, four Canadian soldiers were killed and eight others were seriously injured, when an American Fighter released a five hundred pound bomb on The Canadian Battle Group as they conducted a night time live fire exercise at the Tarnak Farm firing range used by all the coalition forces.



This incident with all the sorrow and sadness that surrounded it led to the renaming of a portion of Highway 401 from Trenton to Toronto, "Highway of Heroes". As the remains of our soldiers were transported from Trenton Air Base, thousands of people showed their respect from the overpasses along the route to Toronto. This is a tradition that carried on over the entire duration of the War in Afghanistan. They shall not grow old......

We seem to have rectified the problems with the accessibility lift (elevator). Apparently, the elevator section foundation of the building has settled over the years. This caused the car to touch the side wall slightly, tripping the safety switch.


