President's Remarks – David Smith

Members, well fall is here and I hope that all of you are staying healthy and well.

The club had its soft opening start on September 17th and will be open Thursday through Saturday from 4PM to 8PM. "Thank You" to all of the members who have come in and supported the club. There are strict Covid Protocols in place for your safety. Please don't forget to sign in and out when you leave the club so we have a record in case contact tracing is required.

The financial numbers after 2 weeks have not been great but we are hoping that we will see and uptick in the numbers now that the weather is getting cooler and we get through the Thanksgiving weekend.

As Covid continues to stay with us and the number of new cases is increasing, the Board will continue to conduct MDVA business following the guidelines as set out under the Ontario Corporations Emergency Rules, which allow us to meet via conference calls or video calls and decision making voting by email and/or telephone.

As you know, we conducted the vote on the Motion to Amend the Constitution via email and/or telephone during the 2 weeks ending on September 18th. The Motion passed with 56 approval votes, 0 no votes and 2 abstentions. The revised Constitution is now in effect and a copy will be sent to all members.

In the interest of everyone's health and safety, the Board has agreed to cancel all General Meetings through December unless there is a change in the Ministry of Health directives or the current State of Emergency is lifted.

2021 Board Election

Normally we would have Board nominations for the coming year by the end of October with the vote at the November General Meeting. As we have cancelled the General Meetings through the end of the year, the current Board has agreed to remain in place for 2021 in the best interest of the MDVA.

That said, if there are any nominations for President, Treasurer, Secretary and Directors for 2021, then the nomination should be sent via mail or email to the Secretary <u>by October 31st</u>. The Nomination form is attached, which you can complete and mail to the attention of the Secretary. If you choose to nominate a person via email, please make sure you indicate the name of the nominee and the position that they are being nominated for. You must also have an email from the nominee agreeing to run and email that to the Secretary as well. (Send to **markhamveterans@rogers.com**)

The Secretary will pass all nomination documents to the Nomination Chair (Past President). If there are any nominations received, then the Nomination Chair will conduct a vote electronically in November.

In addition to the newsletter each month, we will be sending out a communication to all members on what the Secretary usually presents at the General Meeting. A summary Financial report will be provided and a copy of the current financial statements will be posted at the MDVA for members review.

If there are any decisions that need membership approval, these will be requested via email.

The Secretary or Communications Manager will also send out any emails keeping members informed of specific happenings as well as updating the MDVA website and Face-book application.

There will be a Poppy Campaign this year and Rick Paci and Bill Guiler have coordinated these activities with their poppy volunteers. With Covid, there will not be a table at the Markville Mall this year. Rick and Bill have put into place protocols for the safe distribution of poppies to retailers, pickup of donation boxes and the handling of the monies.

I have spoken to many of you during this time of COVID 19, & I KNOW IT IS REALY HARD BUT PLEASE STAY SAFE .



















Cadet Corner:


