Remembering Passchendaele! October 1917


In the October newsletter, I did a little write up about Passchendaele & received this note from member Patrick King & thought we should share it

"A nice mention of Passchendaele – my grandfather was killed there on Oct 30th, 1917.

We have put up a banner for him this year and the other banner we put up was for my father-in-law who died many years ago but he was taken off the beaches of Dunkirk in early Jun of '40 and survived the war.



This is from the memorial erected at Passchendaele. I think it's the only battalion with its own memorial. My grandfather's name is the bottom left MM "



Cadets are having Marksmanship practice and Rifle Drill at the MDVA Tuesday nights


Also still doing virtual training every Thursday night.
